■ RIA's Certified Mold Professional Certification School is open only to pre-approved Candidates pursuing their RIA Advanced CMP certification. Areas of primary emphasis will include general inspection procedures for contaminants indoors (chemical, biological, particulates, fire residue, etc.) The course emphasizes the inter-relatedness of building systems and the predominance of situations where indoor environmental quality is impacted by multiple problems or contaminants. Candidates will be able to identify what is impacting the interior of a building and which general cleaning approaches would be appropriate for improving the indoor environment.

The course is current and consistent from class to class, and the course text is a series of detailed subject outlines with ancillary technical articles. Course materials will be provided to the participants 2-4 weeks in advance with the understanding that they will scan or read the technical materials before class begins. Candidates will outline a technical article for publication and review it with their peers so that following the completion of the course they will flesh it out and submit it for publication in technical journals. Successful completion of the CMP Certification School and passing the CMP Exam with a passing score of 80% or better, will allow the Candidate to advance to the final stage of the certification process: the submission of a "Capstone Project" or technical paper.
